



## **TUMA SPORTS COMPLEX RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. No person shall engage in any sale of merchandise, services, or operate any concessions without prior written approval.
2. Alcoholic beverages and/or illegal substances are prohibited on City property. Appropriate law enforcement agencies will be notified when violations occur and appropriate action against all involved parties will apply.
3. No grills or cookers are allowed in the Tuma Sports Complex.
4. Glass containers are prohibited in all areas.
5. Staking for tents/structures is prohibited. Tents or canopies must be stabilized by weighted means such as sandbags.
6. No pets are allowed in the Complex. For ADA exceptions, City pet leash and waste laws are to be followed.
7. Skates of any kind, skateboards, and bicycles are prohibited in all areas.
8. Golf carts are for employee use only. Golf carts may only be used by employees of the Tuma Complex or those employed by the concessionaire. Individuals must be 16 years of age in order to operate a golf cart.
9. No golf carts (excepting Sports Complex vehicles) or other similar motorized vehicles shall be permitted on any portion of the complex without the written approval of the City.
10. It is prohibited for any person to engage in boisterous, threatening, abusive, insulting, indecent or profane language or to engage in any disorderly conduct or behavior leading to a breach of the public peace and enjoyment of the facility. The City reserves the right to remove, or have removed, any person(s) due to abusive conduct or a non-cooperative attitude.
11. No person or group shall store, leave, or otherwise allow remaining at the facility, any materials, supplies, equipment or other physical accessories without permission of the City. A reasonable charge may be assessed by the City to remove any such items.
12. No smoking shall be permitted within the Sports Complex. Use of tobacco, including cigarettes, cigars, pipes, and chewing tobacco is strictly prohibited.
13. The City is not responsible for lost or stolen items or for damage occurred by hit, thrown, or moving objects. Please, lock your cars.
14. Food and/or drink may not be brought into the Sports Complex. Exception being that each team may bring in team water or sports drinks for players, coaches, and referees as well as a team snack for youth players after the games.
15. No climbing, hanging, sitting, walking, or standing on/over trees, shrubs, fences, netting, or buildings.
16. Misuse of Complex or failure to abide rules and regulations may include, but not limited to, Tournament Sponsor paying for any damages suffered. Misuse may also result in refusal for future use.
17. No person shall be denied access to or participation in programs because of that person's race, sex, national origin, creed or any other impermissible classification as defined by law.
18. The City reserves the right to remove, or have removed, any person(s) due to a violation of any of these rules.
19. No RV's or motorhomes are allowed in the Complex unless Ok'd by the Complex Coordinator prior to the event.
